H-Scarlet has been an outstanding broodmare for Little Brook Farm, and is a great farm favorite indeed. Her sire- H-Goshawk, also bred by the Cross Ranch is the product of a mating between H-Chester and Muchacha. Muchacha was a 1956 mare , also bred by George Cross, who was the dam of the well known H-Ken by Kenfield.

H-Goshawk's sire H-Chester was the sire of 19 foals, and was also Cross Ranch bred. He was by Kenfield out of La Pluma. Kenfield was by Speedfield by Fleetfield. While US Government Farm on his top sire line, Kenfield, through Speedfield's dam Cherye- who also had a US Government sire line, brought with her the old Jackson Ranch bloodlines using Delbert. Delbert's dam was Alibirdie- a Sellman bred mare- so Kenfield has that infusion of well tested and highly regarded bloodline. Cherye's dam was Chiretta, she by Revelation out of Kathleen Mollie O. Revelation was bred by Charles Beck of Maplewood, MO. He, on his sire line, went back to Denning Allen by Honest Allen- going back to Sherman Morgan three times through Black Hawk Morgan, The Brooks Horse, and Cock of The Rock. Revelation also, on his sire line went back to Daniel Lambert through Lambert B. On his dam's side Revelation carried the blood of Jubilee De Jarnette through Jupiter his son, out of the Brunk mare Senata by Senator out of Daisy by Billy Bodette, who also went back to Sherman Morgan multiple times through Royal Morgan, Billy Root, and Green Mountain Morgan. Billy Bodette also carried a little known mare line to Justin Morgan himself. That mare was The Old Charlie Watson Mare. Kathleen Mollie O was also bred by Charles Beck of Maplewood, MO. Her pedigree is somewhat different from that of Revelation. She was by Colonel North, also bred by Mr. Beck, but with an infusion of both Standardbred and Saddlebred blood. Those coming

through Mambrino Chief and Hambletonian. It is through Colonel North's paternal grandmother- the EW Fox Mare who goes back to Black Hawk Morgan that brings in Morgan Blood. Colonel North's sire was Vivace who was out of the EW Fox Mare and therefore gained his Morgan blood.

Vivace also had lines to both Woodbury Morgan, and Bulrush Morgan through his paternal great grandmother Lady Griswold. Colonel North's dam was Robena Reade- she by the triple registered stallion Charles Reade (Morgan, Standardbred, and Saddlebred-Standardbred by dint of race time, Saddlebred by being taken into that breed as foundation stock). Charles Reade was by Woodward's Ethan Allen by Ethan Allen by Black Hawk Morgan. The dam of Charles Reade was Princess Dagmar. She was sired by Daniel Lambert and out of a daughter of Ethan Allen by Black Hawk Morgan. The Benjamin E Bates mare by name. Since Daniel Lambert was also by Ethan Allen within this one branch of the pedigree (Charles Reade's) Ethan Allen appears no less than three times close up. The dam of Kathleen Mollie O was Contralto, also by Charles Reade and out of the mare Prima Donna who was by the Thoroughbred stallion Inspector out of the Morgan Thomas LaFon Mare.

The dam of Kenfield was Lora Lie. Lora Lie was also by Fleetfield, sire of Speedfield who was Kenfield's sire. Kenfield therefore was the result of half brother to half sister breeding. Actually more than that since Lora Lie was out of Loretta who was out of a full sister to Chiretta, dam of Cherye who was dam of Speedfield. Fleetfield was by Mentor out of Norma, a full brother to the Eastern Show Horse Trophy, and the well known mares Silkolene and Tivioli. Watch Cham was the sire of Loretta. Watch Charm was by Chief Bugler and out of Pretty also by Chief Bugler. This gives Watch Charm four crosses to Jubilee De Jarnette- two on each side of his pedigree. Gala Girl was the dam of Chief Bugler and she carried an additional cross to Daniel Lambert through her dam- Hostess, giving Watch Cham two more crosses to Daniel Lambert.

La Pluma was the dam of H-Chester, sire of H-Goshawk . She was by the creme or perlino stallion Chingadero. Chingadero was bred by George Cross and sired 137

offspring. He was sired by Ketchum and out of buckskin Haager. Both Ketchum and Haager were bred by George Cross. Ketchum was sired by the Warhawk son Joe Lewis. Haager- was sired by Warhawk- a grandson to daughter mating, thus producing Chingadero.

Warhawk was by Flyhawk out of Sentola, the full sister to Jubilee King by Penrod out of Daisette. The dam of Joe Lewis was Homely Girl by Glider by Jubilee King and out of Gizea by Go Hawk (sire of Flyhawk) out of Liza Jane. This is concentrated breeding based on that of Joseph Brunk. Ketchum's dam was Du Noir Strip, also by Warhawk and out of the unregistered mare Strip by Imperial out of Red Cross Nurse by Taters. Haager's dam was Yellow Girl. Yellow Girl was sired by Glider and out of Buck. Buck was unregistered and by Imperial out of unregistered Nellie by unregistered Taters- who did trace to Morgan bloodlines. Yellow Girl produced 17 foals, twelve of which were filly foals. She was also bred by George Cross.

The dam of La Pluma was the Warhawk daughter Teal Eye, again Cross breeding here. Teal Eye was out of Secora by Glider out of Dora. Dora was also by Imperial but out of Miss Helm by a trotting bred horse. Muchacha was the dam of H-Goshawk, she was by Warhawk out of Secora, who was also the dam of Teal Eye.

H-Scarlet's dam was H-Kimono by SH Bold Lad by Johnny Dollar. H-Kimono's dam was H-China by Kenfield out of Chief's Gold by Chief Justin Morgan out of Haager. SH Bold Lad was bred by Scarlet Hills Morgans, then of Lander, WY- now of Shoshoni, WY. He sired 29 offspring, the majority of them for the Cross Ranch. Johnny Dollar his sire was a black 1964 stallion who sired 77 foals. Johnny Dollar was sired by Shadow Hawk by Flyhawk out of Sentimental . Sentimental was by Sentiment by Major Reade by Charles Reade and out of Senata by Senator out of Daisy. Sentiment was bred to his daughter Bonnie Blue to produce Sentimental. Bonnie Blue was out of Roany a 1919 mare who traced back to Black Hawk Morgan. The dam of Johnny Dollar was Bright Star by Congo out of Mary R.M. . Congo , a 1940 black stallion bred by J.Roy Brunk , sired 61 foals. He was Grand Champion stallion at the 1974 Illinois State Fair. Congo's breeding is a blend of US Government Farm, Daniel Lambert/Sherman breeding, with both Go Hawk and

Jubilee King's sister Sentola, as well as Knox Morgan. He was sired by Tarron, by Tiffany, by Mansfield. Through Tarron, his sire, comes the blood of Knox Morgan, Allen Franklin, Jubilee De Jamette, and Ben Franklin, all from Tarron's dam- African Maid, bred by J.C. Brunk. It was Congo's dam Black Dee who brought in Go Hawk through her sire Herodon, a son of Go Hawk. Herodon's dam was Galva, also bred by the Brunks. Galva was by Billy Herod out of Chista. Billy Herod goes back to Sherman Morgan through Black Hawk Morgan, King Herod, and of course Herod. Chista was by Chetco, by Ben Franklin by Daniel Lambert. Chista was also bred by JC Brunk and Galva was her only offspring. Chetco's dam was Nellie B, she was by Harry Allen Jr. by Harry Allen by Daniel Lambert. Harry Allen Jr.'s dam was an own daughter of Royal Morgan by Sherman Morgan. Nellie B had yet more Sherman Morgan blood through Royal Morgan again on her dam's side, as well as from Billy Root and the Batchelder Horse both by Sherman Morgan. Chista's dam was Lucy by Billy Bodette- adding yet more Sherman Morgan blood. Lucy's dam brought more of the blood of Billy Root, and the Batchelder Horse both by Sherman. Very heavy Sherman Morgan blood indeed was Chista's contribution to Galva and through her to Herodon and his grandson Congo. SH Bold Lad's dam was Bess S Beauty. She was by Beckridge Como and out of Flashy Bess by Stetson- son of Flyhawk. Beckridge Como was by Montey Vermont out of Milholm Coronation by Stellar- which is US Government Farm breeding. Montey Vermont however was out of Ginger Vermont which is again Brunk breeding- Ginger Vermont being by Red Vermont (Jubilee King X Daisy Knox). But Ginger Vermont also brought in the bloodlines used by the LU Sheep Company through her dam Dawnglo. Dawnglo was sired by Night Tide- a JC Brunk bred stallion by Tiffany, and out of Glenalla who was by Allen King, a full brother to Penrod, sire of Jubilee King, and out of Ruby Reade by Charles Reade out of Ruby by Jubilee De Jamette X Bess Franklin by Chetco. Dawnglo's dam was Ishawooa who was by Linspar by Linsley out of Coalie a Flyhawk daughter. This is classic LU breeding indeed as Coalie's dam was an LU Ranch mare by Morgan Patch out of " an LU Mustang".

Milholm Coronation's dam – Her Majesty- was by Sonfield out of a daughter of Querido- pure US Government Farm breeding here.

Flashy Bess was the dam of Bess S Beauty, she was by Stetson out of Crimson Lady by Prince Dandy. Stetson's dam was Sentola . The Flyhawk /Sentola cross produced some very highly regarded horses and was considered a "Golden Cross". Stetson was indeed among those highly regarded horses. Stetson was bred by Helen Brunk Greenwalt, and later owned by Ramul Dvarishkis. He was a 1944 dark Chestnut stallion, standing 15.2 hands, the sire of eighty eight offspring. Flashy Bess's dam-Crimson Lady , was by Prince Dandy, out of Mountain Queen by Plains King. Prince Dandy was bred by Eddie Dvarishkis of Sunshine, WY, but owned by Ramul Dvarishkis of Hamilton Dome, WY. Prince Dandy sired eight offspring, he was a chestnut , 1946 stallion. Prince Dandy was sired by King De Jamette, by Jubilee King out of Deura. Deura was by Senator Knox, as was Daisette, dam of Jubilee King. Senator Knox was by the Knox Morgan out of the lovely Senata. Thus, Prince Dandy was a double Knox Morgan descendant and since Deura was out of Penala who was by Penrod- sire of Jubilee King- the top side of Prince Dandy's pedigree is very rich in the blood of Daniel Lambert, with the very solid blood of Knox Morgan – giving him a heritage of Sherman Morgan and the Ancient Vermont bred Morgans. Penala, Deura's dam was out of Galva- by Billy Herod out of Chista. Galva was also the dam of Herodon behind Congo. Prince Dandy's dam was Box K Scarlett. Box K Scarlett's sire Plains King was of US Government Farm breeding being by Romanesque by Red Oak out of Ella Linsley by Linsley. Romanesque's dam was Mariah K by the Headlight Morgan out of Sweet Marie. Mariah K was a Sellman mare , as was her dam Sweet Marie- giving Mariah K the blend of Sherman, Woodbury, and Bulrush that so characterized Richard Sellman's breed and made his horses so sought after. Ella Linsley also had a cross to Headlight Morgan through her paternal grandmother Sunflower Maid, the dam of Linsley. Strong breeding represented here indeed. Lemax was the dam of Ella Linsley, and she also had a cross to Headlight Morgan, through her maternal grandmother Helen S, who was the dam of Bird Hudson, dam of Lemax. Dude Hudson was the sire of Bird Hudson, and his pedigree was rich in the blood of Sherman Morgan through BlackHawk, Billy Root, and King Herod . Sparhawk was the sire of Lemax, he was a 1913 dark chestnut stallion who while siring only 6 registered Morgan filly foals,

sired 95 part Morgans for the US Remount Service in five years. Sparhawk was by Dart out of Lucy Hale. Dart was by Dude out of Bess Franklin. Dude was by Fred out of the John Timmerman Mare- who went to Woodbury and Bulrush Morgan. Fred was sired by Captain Herod by King Herod Jr. King Herod Jr. went back to Sherman Morgan on both sides of his papers. Doll, dam of Fred, sire of Dude went back to Woodbury Morgan through Gifford and Hale's Green Mountain Morgan. She also carried a line to Sherman through Cock Of The Rock. There is a line to Bulrush behind Doll, through the mare who was the dam of Young Green Mountain Morgan, by Hales Green Mountain Morgan. Dart's dam Bess Franklin was by the Ben Franklin son Chetco. Ben Franklin was by Daniel Lambert. This is the top side of Sparhawk's pedigree. His dam was Lucy Hale, her sire was St.L, by Rancho, this line traces back to Justin Morgan through The Hawkins Horse, one of Justin Morgans lesser known sons. St.L was out of Ben's Daisy by Ben Franklin by Daniel Lambert. So St. L had both Sherman Morgan and The Hawkins Horse blood of Justin Morgan. There are actually two crosses to Hawkins Horse behind St.L on his sire line, the other through the Gilmore Mare. Ethel L was the dam of Lucy Hale. Ethel L was by Ned Norton. Ned Norton carried the blood of Woodbury through his grandsire, Gifford Morgan, and that of Bulrush through his dam's sire Flying Morgan. Old Kit was the dam of Ned Norton. Ethel L.'s dam was the F.A. Shepard mare who carried Sherman Morgan through BlackHawk through Peacock her grandsire, and also she had a line to Pilot through her sire the Duffy Horse. Whether Pilot was Canadian or Morgan is not known for certain. He came down from Canada, and went from Connecticut to New York, to New Orleans to Kentucky- leaving offspring behind him and impressing people with his pacing speed. This is Sparhawk's pedigree, and it is an interesting one. Getting back to Box K Scarlett's pedigree, her dam was Syble by NightTide out of Jane by Flyhawk. NightTide was the sire of Dawnglo behind SH Bold Lad. Syble by Flyhawk out of Jane was bred by the Antler's Ranch of Sunshine, WY. Jane was an unregistered Antler's Ranch mare.

Mountain Queen was the dam of Crimson Lady. She was by Plains King and out of Spruce. Plains King was the sire of Box K Scarlett – see above. Spruce was by

Flyhawk out of Sox. Spruce was bred by the LU Sheep Company of Dickie, WY. Sox, her dam, was by Linspar by Linsley out of Sparbelle. Sparbelle was Sparhawk, out of Donbelle by Donald out of Belle C. Graves. Donbelle is of Ancient Vermont breeding going back to Billy Root, The Streeter Horse, Hales Green Mountain Morgan, Cushing's Green Mountain, Ethan Allen and Woods Comet. Sparhawk has been described earlier in this evaluation, as the sire of Lemax behind Ella Linsley. Nancy was the dam of Sox. Nancy was sired by Flyhawk out of Lucy. Lucy was also LU Sheep Co. bred by a son of Dan Patch (American Trotting Register) who traced to Star of the West, Flying Cloud and Black Hawk Morgan.

The dam of H-Kimono (dam of H-Scarlet) was H-China , a 1970 palomino mare by Kenfield out of Chief's Gold. Kenfield was the sire of H-Chester who was the sire of H-Goshawk. sire of H-Scarlet. Chief's Gold a 1959 palomino was by Chief Justin Morgan and out of Haager. Haager was the dam of Chingadero, sire of La Pluma who was behind H-Goshawk. Chief Justin Morgan, sire of Chief's Gold was by Brunkey who was by the Jubilee King son Juzan. Brunkey's dam was Fanita by Tiffany by Mansfield, and out of Benita by the Knox Morgan out of Ben's Daisy by Ben Franklin by Daniel Lambert. Classic old combination of Government / Sherman breeding here and up close. Mylynda was the dam of Chief Justin Morgan. She was by King De Jarnette out of Glenalla. Prince Dandy was sired by King De Jamette. Glenalla was sired by Allen King and out of Ruby Reade. Allen King was the full brother to Penrod, sire of Jubilee King and Ruby Reade was by Charles Reade out of Ruby by Jubilee De Jamette out of Bess Franklin who was by Chetco a son of Ben Franklin. Bess Franklin's dam was Bessie by Mountaineer . Mountaineer goes back to Billy Root- more Sherman Morgan blood. Bessie's dam was the Joseph Barber Mare by Billy Folsom. She was out of Soloman Berry Mare who was a granddaughter of Royal Morgan who was by Sherman Morgan. The Soloman Berry Mare also had a line to Randolph Morgan by Bulrush Morgan.

It is little wonder then with all the Sherman Morgan influence that H-Scarlet has, in addition to the amount of old US Government blood that she has, that she

possesses a deep, balanced body with powerful hindquarters and a lovely head and eye- which she consistently passes on to her foals. With those behind her in the quantity they are present she should indeed be an outstanding broodmare who not only is correct and baroque in type, but who has a pleasant disposition which has made her a favorite at Little Brook Farm.
