These two palomino mares of Little Brook Farm have shown themselves to be highly talented as well as beautiful.. LBF Mona Lisa has produced her first foal LBF Diamond Jim Brady after being out in the world as a little bit of everything- from Parade Horse to Competitive Trail Horse to being trusted with grandchildren. Her sister Firefly, besides being the last foal of their sire H-Ken, has been out in Dressage and Hunter Paces. They come by their abilities naturally indeed.

H-Ken their sire was by Kenfield out of Muchacha. H-Ken was of Cross Ranch breeding, and Kenfield was bred by Gerald Weingart of Winnett, Montana. The dam of Kenfield was Lora Lie. Lora Lie was by Fleetfield, sire of Speedfield who was Kenfield's sire. Kenfield therefore was the result of half brother to half sister breeding. Actually more than that since Lora Lie was out of Loretta who was out of a full sister to Chiretta, dam of Cherye who was dam of Speedfield. Fleetfield was by Mentor out of Norma, a full brother to the Eastern Show Horse Trophy, and the well known mares Silkolene and Tivioli. Watch Charm was the sire of Loretta. Watch Charm was by Chief Bugler and out of Pretty also by Chief Bugler. This gives Watch Charm four crosses to Jubilee De Jarnette- two on each side of his pedigree. Gala Girl was the dam of Chief Bugler and she carried an additional cross to Daniel Lambert through her dam- Hostess, giving Watch Cham two more crosses to Daniel Lambert. While US Government Farm on his top sire line, Kenfield, through Speedfield's dam Cherye- who also had a US Government sire line, brought with her the old Jackson Ranch bloodlines using Delbert. Delbert's dam was Alibirdie- a Sellman bred mare- so Kenfield has that infusion of well tested and highly regarded bloodline. Cherye's dam was Chiretta, she by Revelation out of Kathleen Mollie O. Revelation was bred by Charles Beck of Maplewood, MO. He, on his sire line, went back to Denning Allen by Honest Allen- going back to Sherman Morgan three times

through Black Hawk Morgan, The Brooks Horse, and Cock of The Rock. Revelation also, on his sire line went back to Daniel Lambert through Lambert B. On his dam's side Revelation carried the blood of Jubilee De Jarnette through Jupiter his son, out of the Brunk mare Senata by Senator out of Daisy by Billy Bodette, who also went back to Sherman Morgan multiple times through Royal Morgan, Billy Root, and Green Mountain Morgan. Billy Bodette also carried a little known mare line to Justin Morgan himself. That mare was The Old Charlie Watson Mare. Kathleen Mollie O was also bred by Charles Beck of Maplewood, MO. Her pedigree is somewhat different from that of Revelation. She was by Colonel North, also bred by Mr. Beck, but with an infusion of both Standardbred and Saddlebred blood. Those coming through Mambrino Chief and Hambletonian. It is through Colonel North's paternal grandmother- the EW Fox Mare who goes back to Black Hawk Morgan that brings in Morgan Blood. Colonel North's sire was Vivace who was out of the EW Fox Mare and therefore gained his Morgan blood.

Vivace also had lines to both Woodbury Morgan, and Bulrush Morgan through his paternal great grandmother Lady Griswold. Colonel North's dam was Robena Reade- she by the triple registered stallion Charles Reade (Morgan, Standardbred, and Saddlebred-Standardbred by dint of race time, Saddlebred by being taken into that breed as foundation stock). Charles Reade was by Woodward's Ethan Allen by Ethan Allen by Black Hawk Morgan. The dam of Charles Reade was Princess Dagmar. She was sired by Daniel Lambert and out of a daughter of Ethan Allen by Black Hawk Morgan. The Benjamin E Bates mare by name. Since Daniel Lambert was also by Ethan Allen within this one branch of the pedigree (Charles Reade's) Ethan Allen appears no less than three times close up. The dam of Kathleen Mollie O was Contralto, also by Charles Reade and out of the mare Prima Donna who was by the Thoroughbred stallion Inspector out of the Morgan Thomas LaFon Mare. Muchacha was another Cross Ranch bred mare. She was by the Flyhawk son Warhawk, and out of Secora by the Jubilee King son Glider. Muchacha was also the dam of H-Goshawk, as well as H-Isabella. Warhawk was by Flyhawk out of Sentola, the full sister to Jubilee King by Penrod out of Daisette. Warhawk was another of the famous 'Golden Cross' which produced Stetson, The Airacobra, Top Flight, and the

very productive mare Jubilee Joy. Sentola, dam of Warhawk was by Penrod out of Daisette. Therefore she carried the rich bloodlines of Ben Franklin and Jubilee De Jarnette, going back to Daniel Lambert back to Sherman Morgan. In addition Sentola had the blood of Knox Morgan through her dam Daisette a daughter of Senator Knox who was by Knox Morgan out of JC Brunk's beautiful mare Senata by Senator out of Daisy by Billy Bodette.

Flyhawk, of course was by Go Hawk and brought in the blood of Bulrush Morgan through Hero of Manila who traced to Morrill by The Jennison Colt. Flyhawk also carried one line to Revenge, one of Justin Morgan's lessor known sons. From Florette, his dam, Flyhawk added yet more Sherman Morgan blood. Hero of Manila also brought in more Sherman Morgan blood through the Herod family. And of course Flyhawk also had a line to Knox Morgan through his dam Florette who was out of Florence Chandler by Knox Morgan out of Senata.

Secora, the dam of Muchacha produced ten foals, seven of them filly foals. She was a Cross Ranch mare and her produce seemed to continue on as ranch horses. Her sire, Glider was by Jubilee King and out of Gizea who was a half sister to Flyhawk since Gizea was by Go Hawk and out of the Knox Morgan daughter Liza Jane. Like Secora, Glider remained a ranch horse sire and accordingly beyond the Cross Ranch was not well known. He was bred by JC Brunk, and as the saying goes 'born to the purple'.

He sired -it seems- only filly foals including Yellow Girl, Homely Girl, Du Noir Strip, Bay Race Mare, and of course Secora. Secora's dam was Dora by Imperial. Though the pedigree of Imperial certainly warranted his name that of Dora's dam was not near it in depth or Morgan quality. Dora's dam (Miss Helm) was sired by John Helm's Horse a Trotting horse, Miss Helm's dam is untraced. Imperial however carried the bloodlines of Jubilee De Jarnette, The Admiral, Winnabago Chief, and Morrill Queen. This combination of bloodlines is most frequently found in the early Sellman breeding program though Imperial was never part of that.

H-Ken himself was not a big horse, nor did he sire big horses, but what they may have lacked in physical size they more than made up for in willingness, heart, and

athletic ability.

Rocking M Rosa Lita was by Rocking M Morgan Gold out of Circle H Nopalita. Rocking M Rosa Lita is the produce of breeding a mare to her own grandson. This makes her pedigree predominantly Brunk and Old California. Rocking M Morgan Gold was by Rocking M Diamond D who in turn was by Beckridge Como out of Circle H Nopalita. Beckridge Como was by Montey Vermont out of Milholm Coronation by Stellar- which is US Government Farm breeding. Stellar was by Mentor out of Naiad. Mentor was by Goldfield by Mansfield out of Juno. Naiad was by the half Morgan half Saddlebred stallion Hudson. Hudson's dam was Redfern a full sister to Mansfield, Canfield, Querido, and Ulysses being by Bennington out of Artemisia. Hudson's sire was Admiral Denmark .

Montey Vermont by Keystone who was of a somewhat different line of Government breeding through his sire Pomulus. Pomulus was indeed US Government breeding by Escort out of Viola. Escort was by McMahon Morgan General , a double grandson of General Gates with both grandams being of Lambert blood. Viola was also by General Gates out of Marguerite who was also the dam of Red Oak who was instrumental in the breeding program of Richard Sellman. The dam of Pomulus was Oroloma by Troubadour of Willowmoor and out of Ruth- of Old Vermont breeding. Keystone's dam was Redlass by Redman- an early California stallion of great fame and renown. The dam of Redlass was the Jubilee King granddaughter Easter Lass. by Juzan out of African Maid. Montey Vermont was out of Ginger Vermont which is again Brunk breeding- Ginger Vermont being by Red Vermont (Jubilee King X Daisy Knox). But Ginger Vermont also brought in the bloodlines used by the LU Sheep Company through her dam Dawnglo. Dawnglo was sired by Night Tide- a JC Brunk bred stallion by Tiffany, and out of Glenalla who was by Allen King, a full brother to Penrod, sire of Jubilee King, and out of Ruby Reade by Charles Reade out of Ruby by Jubilee De Jamette X Bess Franklin by Chetco. Dawnglo's dam was Ishawooa who was by Linspar by Linsley out of Coalie a Flyhawk daughter. This is classic LU breeding indeed as Coalie's dam was an LU Ranch mare by Morgan Patch out of “ an LU Mustang”.

Milholm Coronation's dam – Her Majesty-was by Sonfield out of Iva a daughter of

Querido- pure US Government Farm breeding here. Iva's dam was Luaia, bred by Roland G. Hill of California. She was sired by Pat Allen by Allen King by Allen Franklin. Pat Allen's dam was Patrona by Senator Reade out of Black Bess by Jubilee De Jarnette. Senator Reade was by Strawn Reade by Charles Reade, out of J.C.Brunk's mare Senata. Luaia's dam was the Richard Sellman mare Hemala by Headlight Morgan out of Baby Lu by The Admiral by Jubilee De Jarnette. Rocking M Morgan Gold's dam was the beautiful Canadian palomino mare Joley Blond. She was by Morspeed by Speedfield out of Mortana Retta a mare by Rosefield, who was a son of Sonfield out of the JC Jackson mare Detta by Delbert out of Etta by Chief Bugler. Delbert was bred by the US Livestock Experiment Station at Miles City, Montana and was purchased by JC Jackson expressly for use on the Chief Bugler daughters he had. Delbert was a prolific sire having sixty four registered colts and 27 filly foals. He was sired by Revere (Mansfield x Folly) out of the Sellman mare Alibirdie who was a granddaughter of both Red Oak and Headlight Morgan. Joley Blond's dam was June Fib a double Morgan Gold granddaughter. June Fib was sired by the strikingly handsome palomino stallion Silverton Morgan and out of the highly regarded mare Iyoksica. Iyoksica was by Highland Glen out of Beauty Panic. Highland Glen in addition to being a grandson of Escort (behind Montey Vermont) was by Justin's Silhouette which bloodline goes back to Sea Quail, and Quintessence by Jubilee De Jarnette going back to Daniel Lambert again through Lambert Chief. Additionally Highland Glen carried a line to the famous stallion Golddust who stood in Kentucky during the Civil War years. The dam of Iyoksica was Beauty Panic- a mare carrying three crosses to Winterset who was grandsire of Will Rogers who was the sire of Red Correll. Red Correll was the sire of Morgan Gold who was the sire of Silverton Morgan. June Fib's dam was Fibbie, a full sister to Silverton Morgan.

Circle H Nopalita the dam of both Rocking M Rosa Lita and Rocking M Diamond D, was sired by the pure Brunk bred stallion Condo. Condo was bred by J.Roy Brunk , he was used by The Mosher Brothers for ranch work, and sired 187 foals. Condo was a big, black stallion with an excellent rear end, sturdy and of good temperament. He was by Congo out of May Burger. Congo was by Tarron out of

Black Dee. Tarron was by Tiffany out of African Maid by Allen King out of the Knox Morgan daughter Frances Knox whose dam was Bess Franklin by Chetco- going back to Daniel Lambert. Black Dee, dam of Congo, was by Herodon by Go Hawk out of the Jubilee King full sister Sentola. Condo's dam May Burger was by Squire Burger (sire of Whippoorwill Duke) sired by Juzan by Jubilee King. May Burger's dam was African Maid, dam of Tarron. Lita Spar was the dam of Circle H Nopalita. Lita Spar possessed old California breeding. She was by Lee Spar by Dude Spar by Sparbeau. Sparbeau in turn was sired by Linsley out of Sparbelle who was out of Donbelle. Dude Spar who was the double grandsire of Lita Spar was out of the Roland Hill mare Sallie Ann by Querido, out of the Sellman mare Sonna by Sooner a Sellman bred stallion by Headlight Morgan out of Nancy, a daughter of The Admiral. The Admiral was also the sire of Sooner's dam Nannie L. Lee Spar, sire of Lita Spar was out of Iva Lee Field by Sonfield out of Iva who is behind Milholm Coronation's dam – Her Majesty. Lita Spar's dam was Esterlita. Esterlita was by the Romanesque son Joaquin Morgan who was out of Margett L by Linsley out of Donbelle. Which makes Margett L a full sister to Sparbelle, dam of Sparbeau. Bessie Ro was Esterlita's dam. She was by Querido (Bennington x Artemisia) out of Roboss. Bessie Ro was a Roland Hill bred mare, and Roboss was one of the Sellman mares who went to California and into ownership of Roland Hill. Roboss was out of Bossie A and sired by Red Oak. Bossie A was by Major Antoine out of a Major Gordon daughter. Red Oak was by General Gates out of the Ancient Vermont bred Marguerite.

This is the pedigree of Rocking M Rosa Lita- one rich in Brunk, Sellman, Old Vermont, Old California and US Government Farm, Remount stallion's and the precious blood of Red Correll. It is little wonder that her daughters LBF Mona Lisa and Firefly are not only colorful and beautiful, but possess a high degree of Morgan type, soundness, breeding strength, willingness and heart.
