

Rocking M Rosa Lita
Rocking M Morgan Gold X Circle H Nopalita
May , 1990 Palomino Mare
Bred By Rocking M Morgan Ranch, Canada

Rocking M Rosa Lita was a excellent broodmare for Little Brook Farm, she produced five foals for Little Brook, LBF Mona Lisa, her full sister Firefly, LBF Hckory Smoke, LBF Carmalita and BF Call Me Madam. All five were colorful, three smokey blacks and two palomino's. She was not ridden much as she was otherwise occupied producing good foals.

Rocking M Rosa Lita was by Rocking M Morgan Gold out of Circle H Nopalita. Rocking M Rosa Lita is the produce of breeding a mare to her own grandson. This makes her pedigree predominantly Brunk and Old California. Rocking M Morgan Gold was by Rocking M Diamond D who in turn was by Beckridge Como out of Circle H Nopalita. Beckridge Como was by Montey Vermont out of Milholm Coronation by Stellar- which is US Government Farm breeding. Stellar was by Mentor out of Naiad. Mentor was by Goldfield by Mansfield out of Juno. Naiad was by the half Morgan half Saddlebred stallion Hudson. Hudson's dam was Redfem a full sister to Mansfield, Canfield, Querido, and Ulysses being by Bennington out of Artemisia. Hudson's sire was Admiral Denmark .

Montey Vermont by Keystone who was of a somewhat different line of Government breeding through his sire Pomulus. Pomulus was indeed US Government breeding by Escort out of Viola. Pomulus while of US Government breeding was in fact bred by The Maxwell Lodge of Lakeside, WA. He was a very upheaded, compact and typy stallion. Escort was by McMahon Morgan General , a double grandson of General Gates with both grandams being of Lambert blood. McMahon Morgan General's sire was Scotland by General Gates, and his dam was Beauty by General Gates out of Coming Trotter by Motion, a son of Daniel Lambert. Scotland's dam was Highland Mary by Lambert Chief by Daniel Lambert. Viola was

also by General Gates out of Marguerite who was also the dam of Red Oak who was instrumental in the breeding program of Richard Sellman. Marguerite was by White River Morgan who goes back to Woodbury Morgan through Gifford Morgan. The John P March mare was the dam of Marguerite and she went back to Black Hawk Morgan on both sides of her pedigree. White River Morgan also went back to Black Hawk Morgan through The Churchill Horse who appears on the John P March Mares pedigree as her maternal grandsire.. The Churchill Horse has the same relationship to White River Morgan.

The dam of Pomulus was Oroloma by Troubadour of Willowmoor and out of Ruth- of Old Vermont breeding. Troubadour of Willowmoor was of instrumental influence to the US Government farm's breeding program. He was bred by J.W. Clise of Redmond, WA and sired fifty three Registered Morgan foals. His sire was Troubadour a son of Jubilee De Jamette. Troubadour was bred by C.X Larrabee of Home Park, Montana. Troubadour's dam was Bird Pepper who goes back to Sherman Morgan through BlackHawk, via Blood's Black Hawk on her sire side, and back to both Ethan Allen through Superb and Daniel Lambert through Colonel Moulton on her dam's side. Keystone's dam was Redlass by Redman- an early California stallion of great fame and renown. The dam of Redlass was the Jubilee King granddaughter Easter Lass. by Juzan out of African Maid. Montey Vermont was out of Ginger Vermont which is again Brunk breeding- Ginger Vermont being by Red Vermont (Jubilee King X Daisy Knox). But Ginger Vermont also brought in the bloodlines used by the LU Sheep Company through her dam Dawnglo. Dawnglo was sired by Night Tide- a JC Brunk bred stallion by Tiffany, and out of Glenalla who was by Allen King, a full brother to Penrod, sire of Jubilee King, and out of Ruby Reade by Charles Reade out of Ruby by Jubilee De Jamette X Bess Franklin by Chetco. Dawnglo's dam was Ishawooa who was by Linspar by Linsley out of Coalie a Flyhawk daughter. This is classic LU breeding indeed as Coalie's dam was an LU Ranch mare by Morgan Patch out of “ an LU Mustang”.

Milholm Coronation's dam – Her Majesty-was by Sonfield out of Iva a daughter of Querido- pure US Government Farm breeding here. Sonfield was by Mansfield out of the Troubadour of Willowmoor daughter- Quietude. Iva was by Querido by

Bennington out of Artemisia. Iva's dam was Luaia, bred by Roland G. Hill of California. She was sired by Pat Allen by Allen King by Allen Franklin. Pat Allen's dam was Patrona by Senator Reade out of Black Bess by Jubilee De Jarnette. Senator Reade was by Strawn Reade by Charles Reade, out of J.C.Brunk's mare Senata. Luaia's dam was the Richard Sellman mare Hemala by Headlight Morgan out of Baby Lu by The Admiral by Jubilee De Jarnette.

Rocking M Morgan Gold's dam was the beautiful Canadian palomino mare Joley Blond. She was by Morspeed who was bred by CE Norbury of Armstrong BC, Canada. Morspeed was by Speedfield, who was bred by JC Jackson of Harrison, MT, out of Mortana Retta. Mortana Retta was a mare by Rosefield, who was a son of Sonfield out of the JC Jackson mare Detta by Delbert out of Etta by Chief Bugler. All the sire lines on Chief Bugler's pedigree go to Daniel Lambert, including such horses as Jubilee De Jarnette, and Lambert Boy. The dam lines contain Lady De Jarnette, Inee, and Indianola- all well known and highly respected mares, Lady De Jarnette especially. Delbert was bred by the US Livestock Experiment Station at Miles City, Montana and was purchased by JC Jackson expressly for use on the Chief Bugler daughters he had. Delbert was a prolific sire having sixty four registered colts and 27 filly foals. He was sired by Revere (Mansfield x Folly) out of the Sellman mare Alibirdie who was a granddaughter of both Red Oak and Headlight Morgan.

Morspeed there fore was an interesting blend of Old Montana, US Government Remount, and Sellman breeding. Joley Blond's dam was June Fib a double Morgan Gold granddaughter.

June Fib was sired by the strikingly handsome palomino stallion Silverton Morgan by Morgan Gold by Red Correll, and out of the highly regarded mare Iyoksica. Iyoksica was by Highland Glen out of Beauty Panic. Highland Glen in addition to being a grandson of Escort (behind Montey Vermont) was by Justin's Silhouette which bloodline goes back to Sea Quail, and Quintessence by Jubilee De Jarnette going back to Daniel Lambert again through Lambert Chief. Additionally Highland Glen carried a line to the famous stallion Golddust who stood in Kentucky during the Civil War years. The dam of Iyoksica was Beauty Panic- a mare carrying three crosses to Winterset who was grandsire of Will Rogers who was the sire of Red

Correll. Red Correll was the sire of Morgan Gold who was the sire of Silverton Morgan. June Fib's dam was Fibbie, a full sister to Silverton Morgan.

Circle H Nopalita the dam of both Rocking M Rosa Lita and Rocking M Diamond D, was sired by the pure Brunk bred stallion Condo. Condo was bred by J.Roy Brunk, he was used by The Mosher Brothers for ranch work, and sired 187 foals. Condo was a big, black stallion with an excellent rear end, sturdy and of good temperament. He was by Congo out of May Burger. Congo was by Tarron out of Black Dee. Tarron was by Tiffany out of African Maid by Allen King out of the Knox Morgan daughter Frances Knox whose dam was Bess Franklin by Chetco- going back to Daniel Lambert. Black Dee, dam of Congo, was by Herodon by Go Hawk out of the Jubilee King full sister Sentola. Condo's dam May Burger was by Squire Burger (sire of Whippoorwill Duke) sired by Juzan by Jubilee King. May Burger's dam was African Maid, dam of Tarron. Lita Spar was the dam of Circle H Nopalita. Lita Spar possessed old California breeding. She was by Lee Spar by Dude Spar by Sparbeau. Sparbeau in turn was sired by Linsley out of Sparbelle who was out of Donbelle. Dude Spar who was the double grandsire of Lita Spar was out of the Roland Hill mare Sallie Ann by Querido, out of the Sellman mare Sonna by Sooner a Sellman bred stallion by Headlight Morgan out of Nancy, a daughter of The Admiral. The Admiral was also the sire of Sooner's dam Nannie L. Lee Spar, sire of Lita Spar was out of Iva Lee Field by Sonfield out of Iva who is behind Milholm Coronation's dam – Her Majesty. Lita Spar's dam was Esterlita. Esterlita was by the Romanesque son Joaquin Morgan who was out of Margett L by Linsley out of Donbelle. Which makes Margett L a full sister to Sparbelle, dam of Sparbeau. Bessie Ro was Esterlita's dam. She was by Querido (Bennington x Artemisia) out of Roboss. Bessie Ro was a Roland Hill bred mare, and Roboss was one of the Sellman mares who went to California and into ownership of Roland Hill. Roboss was out of Bossie A and sired by Red Oak. Bossie A was by Major Antoine out of a Major Gordon daughter. Red Oak was by General Gates out of the Ancient Vermont bred Marguerite.

This is the pedigree of Rocking M Rosa Lita- one rich in Brunk, Sellman, Old Vermont, Old California, Old Montana, and US Government Farm, Remount stallion's

and the precious blood of Red Correll. It is little wonder that her daughters LBF Mona Lisa and Firefly are not only colorful and beautiful, but possess a high degree of Morgan type, soundness, breeding strength, willingness and heart.
